The group decided that it would get more county officials to attend if we shifted meeting locations to the Llano Library. We served a "pot luck" to tease them out of their offices for a lunch break. It worked! We managed to recruit several of them as members along with new members from the Llano area.



HLRW was successful in gathering sizable groups in the community when we had speakers from the State leadership, those running for office, even on the National Senate and House level. There is a speakers group out of Austin that was very good at informing us how our Government works, how to make our voices heard, and how to run for office ourselves.

We also gave local community services a voice, giving us an opportunity to support their efforts in our county.

Over the years, HLRW gave over 1,200 dictionaries to the third graders in Llano Elementary and three other Christian and Charter Schools. Each year HLRW gave eight graders of Llano Jr. High, Constitutions. Congratulatory letters were given to the Seniors of Llano High School, along with a Voter Registration. A scholarship was awarded to one student per year.


We collected and donated books for the CareAVan and supported several Veterans groups.
